#### INFORMATION YOU WILL NEED

Make sure to collect as much of following as you can before applying for your benefits:

- For you and everyone else living in your household:
  - ☐ Date of birth and Social Security Number (or government issued ID number)
  - ☐ Income information from multiple sources (wages, social security, unemployment compensation, etc.)
- The types of energy that you use:
  - ☐ Fuel type(s) Electric, natural gas, oil, propane, etc.
  - ☐ Name of the utility that provides your power
  - ☐ Account number (as shown on your bill) for each utility company you have
- Your landlord or property management company information (if applicable).

Your application cannot be processed without this information.

- ☐ Address, Phone number

### UPLOAD YOUR DOCUMENTS

To gain faster online approval of your assistance funds, it is *highly recommended* that you upload any pertinent documents to expedite the application process. Documents uploaded could include:

- □ Photo ID
- ☐ Proof of Wisconsin residency or citizenship: driver's license, rental lease, property tax record, passport or birth certificate
- ☐ Utility bill
- ☐ Documents showing monthly income: check stubs, tax documents or award letters.
