on September 15th, 2022 I dropped my 3 Children off at claycare. After work I returned to the daycare to find that my 17 month old daughter was not there. Trying to get answers and verify my daughter's wellbeing I drove to her father's apartment in Stoughton. When I realized she and he weren't there I drove to his mother's house in Evansville, WI. I knocked on the back cloor. It was taking an extremely long time for someone to answer the cloor but I did hear the owner (my daughter's grand mother) say to someone to "Keep the baby away from the back door") When she finally answered the cloor I asked where my daughter's fother was, what was going daughter's father was sleeping at his father's house. She said no I could not see my daughter and pushed me by the shoulders out of the doorway. It was at this moment I contemplated the need to see my daughter and if it was justified. As the woman had previously endangered my life by smoking weed and then driving, and had endangered the lives of my two older children by driving them without carseats I decided to verify my daughter was alright and stepped around her in an attempt to see my daughter. She was grabbing my arms and pulling at me. Instructed her other son to call 911. Chaos ensured Long story short she would later try to say I assaulted her. That story changed and they tried charging me with Felony Elderly Abuse. All charges of assault and abuse were subsequently dropped. There have been no incidents since Sept. 15,2022

### JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT 256.35(9) Wis. Stats

### **ROCK COUNTY AND CITY OF EVANSVILLE**

Rock County (County) and City of Evansville (Municipality) have combined with other municipalities to establish a sophisticated telecommunications system which automatically connects a person dialing the first "911" to a public safety answering point (PSAP) provides the PSAP with the caller's location and number identification.

Wis. Stats. 256.35(9) requires that County and Municipality annually enter into this Joint Powers Agreement as follows:

- 1) This agreement is applicable on a daily basis.
- If an emergency service vehicle is dispatched in response to a request through the Rock County System, which the Municipality is a part of, such vehicle shall render its services to the persons needing the services regardless of whether the vehicle is operating outside the vehicle's normal jurisdictional boundaries. The intent of this paragraph is to meet the legal requirements of the Wisconsin State Statutes. It is not to assign calls to emergency service departments outside of their defined service areas on a regular basis. Only unusual circumstances will require such assignment.
- 3) Municipality directs the Rock County PSAP Center receiving a call for service in the Municipality's jurisdiction to dispatch the call in the following manner.

### EVANSVILLE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

### INTERGOVERNMENTAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES CONTRACT

SERVICE PROVIDER: City of Evansville, through its Emergency Medical Service

(Referred to as "Provider")

SERVICE RECIPIENTS: Listed Sections of Towns of Union, Porter, Magnolia and

Brooklyn

(Referred to as "Recipients")

TERM OF CONTRACT: January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025.

WHEREAS, the City of Evansville, through its Emergency Medical Service, owns and maintains an ambulance and related equipment and supplies; and recruits, trains, and staffs emergency medical personnel; and

WHEREAS, towns adjoining the City of Evansville have a need for emergency medical services that the City of Evansville can provide; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 66.0301(2), Wis. Stats., municipalities may contract with each other for the furnishing of services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Evansville as Provider and the towns as Recipients desire to provide and receive services under the terms and conditions set forth in this contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Evansville and the Towns agree as follows:

### 1. PROVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

Provider shall provide emergency medical services on a 24 hour per day/ 365 day per year basis in those sections or portions of sections of each town as follows:

- A) Town of Union, Rock County, Wisconsin All Sections except Sections 4 through 7, inclusive, and the north one-half of Section 8;
- B) Town of Porter, Rock County, Wisconsin Sections 4 through 9, 16 through 21, 28 through 33 and the west one-half of Section 34, all inclusive;
- C) Town of Magnolia, Rock County, Wisconsin Sections 1 through 12, 14 through 18, and 20 through 22, all inclusive; and
- D) Town of Brooklyn, Green County, Wisconsin The south one-half of Sections 25 and 26, the southeast quarter of Section 27, the east one-half of Section 34 and all of Sections 35 and 36.

### 2. RENDERING OF SERVICES

The Provider shall endeavor to provide emergency medical services, to the best of its ability given the particular circumstances, to all persons in need of such service within the listed sections of the recipients, whether or not the person is a resident of the Town. It shall be within the discretion of the Provider, its agents and employees, to determine on a case by case basis whether or not a situation constitutes an emergency, whether or not such emergency medical services shall be administered and the extent to which emergency medical services shall be rendered. The Provider shall also have the right to determine the destination and manner or transport of a person serviced, if transport is deemed necessary.

### 3. RESPONSE

Within reason and exercising proper and appropriate discretion, Provider agrees to respond to requests for emergency medical services within the listed sections of the Recipients whether such request comes from Recipient employees, officers or agents, by any law enforcement agency or any other person.

### 4. COST OF SERVICES

The cost for emergency medical services payable by Recipients to Provider shall be twenty-six dollars and ninety-five cents (\$26.9482) per resident in the listed sections of each town, billed annually. Resident population will be the most current Department of Administration population estimate, typically reported in October, or other current estimate the Provider deems more accurate by door-to-door survey, utility bills, 911 services, and/or building permits (Attachment A).

### 5. BILLING OF SERVICES

- A) A person receiving "basic life support" (BLS) emergency medical services will be charged a base rate of \$1,300.00, plus mileage and oxygen/spinal immobilization if rendered, if a Recipient resident covered under Section 1. A person receiving "advanced life support" (ALS) emergency medical services will be charged a base rate of \$1,400.00, plus mileage and oxygen/spinal immobilization if rendered, if a Recipient resident covered under Section 1.
- B) A person receiving BLS emergency medical services will be charged a base rate of \$1,300.00, plus mileage and oxygen/spinal immobilization if rendered, if a City of Evansville resident. A person receiving ALS emergency medical services will be charged a base rate of \$1,400.00, plus mileage and oxygen/spinal immobilization if rendered, if a City of Evansville resident.
- C) A person receiving BLS emergency medical services will be charged a base rate of \$1,300, plus mileage and oxygen/spinal immobilization if rendered, if not a city of Evansville or Recipient resident covered under Section 1 of this contract. A person receiving ALS emergency medical services will be charged a base rate of \$1,400, plus mileage and oxygen/spinal immobilization if rendered, if not a city of Evansville or Recipient resident covered under Section 1 of this contract.
- D) A call fee of \$500 will be charged to the person responded to for emergency medical services if services of Provider are not rendered, required or refused upon arrival. A standby fee of \$500 will be charged for all responses for which standby assistance is requested.
- E) The Provider will bill for services promptly with the information obtained at the time of service, which will contain information as to the date, the name and address of the person serviced, responsible party, and insurance, if any and if known.
- F) Provider will assume responsibility for collection of patient bills and will absorb potential adjustments and write-offs.

### 6. RECORDS MAINTENANCE

Provider shall keep reasonable itemized and detailed work records covering name and address of the person receiving service, other parties involved, date, time and location of service rendered, and the cost of the service performed under this contract.

### 7. EMPLOYEE STATUS

All persons employed by or volunteering services to the Provider in the performance of the services and functions pursuant to the contract shall be the officer, employee or volunteer of the Provider only and shall have no claim to any employment benefits, including but not limited to, pensions, civil service or other rights from the Recipients.

### 8. LIABILITY

Provider shall carry insurance protecting against claims of malpractice or negligence for the acts and omissions of the officers, agents, employees or volunteers of Provider under the contract. Each Recipient shall indemnify and hold harmless the provider, and shall carry insurance protecting against claims for malpractice or negligence for the acts or omissions of any of its officers, agents, employees or volunteers under the contract. Each shall provide any other party to the contract with a certificate of insurance upon request.

### 9. TERM OF CONTRACT

The term shall be for one year as noted in the caption of this contract.

### 10. TERMINATION AMENDMENT AND RENEWAL.

Any party to this contract may terminate its participation in the contract upon 60 days written notice to all other parties. If any Recipient terminates the contract they are obligated to pay the entire annual contract amount. If the City terminates the contract pursuant to this paragraph, the City would refund payments made by the Recipients on a pro-rata basis. The contract does not automatically renew by inaction of Provider or any Recipient. Written agreement of Provider and any Recipient is required on the terms of any amendment or renewal.

### 11. NON-EXCLUSIVE CONTRACT

This contract is not exclusive and Provider may provide emergency medical services to others than parties to this contract; and each Recipient may use any other emergency medical services supplier in addition to Provider.



### Pete's Inn Incidents

03/26/22 - Fire occurred at establishment causing them to close for several months

06/13/23 – Establishment reopens

06/24/23 – Evansville Officers and Rock County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a disturbance in which it was reported that 3-4 people were fighting. Four subjects were cited for Disorderly Conduct and two others were cited for Battery and Disorderly Conduct. Additionally, a vehicle in the vicinity of the altercation was causing nearly \$3,000 in damage. (Reported by staff)

07/02/23 – Officers observed numerous people in the bar after 2:30 a.m. Officers made contact with the bar tenders and issued verbal warnings for serving after hours.

07/22/23 – Evansville Officers along with Rock County Deputies responded to a disturbance in which a subject was battered by another person. Through investigation one person was cited for Disorderly Conduct and Battery. (Reported by victim)

07/31/23 – Sgt Reilly met with Bret and Sheri to discuss the issues that had been going on at the bar. They discussed closing earlier, making sure their staff are calling to have problem patrons removed, etc.

08/06/23 – Staff called to report an intoxicated male at the business who was ultimately transported to hospital by EMS.

09/07/23 – Evansville Officers and Rock County Deputies responded to a disturbance. It was reported there were approximately 7 people fighting in the alley. Upon officer arrival patrons were not forthcoming with information and only one subject reported there was only an argument. (Unknown / Refused Caller)

11/04/23 – Officers responded to a report of a Battery. The victim reported he and his wife were beat up and were requesting an ambulance. Upon arrival officers were unable to locate the caller and no one at the bar reported any issues or having any knowledge of a fight. It was later determined the victim walked home. Through the course of the investigation, it was found there was a large altercation involving 8 subjects. Two victims sought medical attention for their injuries. Six citations were issued for Disorderly Conduct, two for battery, and one for resisting/obstructing an officer. One subject was taken to the jail for a probation violation. This incident required 12 follow-up interviews / investigations. (Reported by victim)

11/11/23 – Two subjects were involved in a domestic dispute between a husband and wife. The wife was ultimately arrested for Domestic Disorderly Conduct, Domestic Battery, and Resist / Obstruct and officer. (Reported by staff)

11/27/23 – Chief Reese and Lt Jones met with Sheri to discuss issues at the bar. Several trespass letters were issued by the PD on behalf of Sheri.

05/02/24 – Evansville Officers and Rock County Deputies were dispatched to a report of approximately 6 subjects fighting. Through investigation it was found that several subjects were acting disorderly and were banned from the bar. It was also reported there may have been someone who was hit during the altercation. Officers requested video footage of the incident but never received it. The case was then closed.

05/26/24 – Officers found several subjects inside the bar drinking after closing time. Sgt Reilly spoke with the bartender who advised that he was having a hard time getting people to leave the bar. He was advised to call the PD if he was having those issues. He was also given a stern warning and that any future violations would result in a citation being issued.

06/23/24 – While Officer Tway was responding another call, he observed a subject outside the bar yelling at patrons inside. Due to him being tied up with another incident Officer Tway ordered the subject to go home. He later responded back to the bar and was advised the male subject was trying to get people to come fight him.

08/11/24 – Staff reported a subject who was yelling and was physical with another patron. Evansville PD and Rock County Deputies responded. After investigation, the suspect was sent home and the other subject involved did not wish to be a victim and the bar wanted him removed for the night.

08/31/24 – Officers and EMS responded to a report of a disturbance in which one subject was report to be unconscious. Upon arrival of officers the victim had regained consciousness and left the scene. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate him. Spoke with the reporting parties who advised they called after the disturbance due to the subject being knocked out. No one on scene reported being a victim of crime and the case was closed unfounded.

09/08/24 – Evansville Officers, Rock County Deputies, Evansville EMS, Evansville Fire, and Janesville Paramedics were dispatched to a report of a Pulseless Non-Breather (PNB). Upon arrival officers determined the subject was likely suffering of an opiate overdose. Officers administered CPR and Narcan before care was turned over to EMS. The subject came to prior to being transported to the hospital. Video of the incident was requested by the PD but the request was never fulfilled. (Reported by witness)

09/14/24 – Officers and EMS responded to the report of a fall victim. Investigation revealed an intoxicated male fall over and hit his head. Witnesses reported the subject had been asleep on the bar for several minutes and when the male came to, he stood up and fell over. He was ultimately transported to the hospital by EMS.

09/14/24 – Officers along with Rock County Deputies responded to a report of a disturbance. Investigation led to two subjects being warned for disorderly conduct.

09/16/24 – Officers, Rock County Deputies, and Evansville Fire and EMS responded to a report of a UTV rollover outside of the bar. Officers found the victims of the crash hiding inside of the bar. One subject was ultimately arrested for OWI causing injury. A request for video was made and the request was never fulfilled as the bar advised they did not have any video.

09/22/24 – Officers responded to a report of a disturbance called in by a third party. Upon arrival patrons advised there was an argument but no one reported being a victim of a crime.
