- Lt. Jones has started his two week front line supervisors course through the DOJ
- Ofc. Johnson successfully completed intoxalyzer training
- Sgt. Reilly has set up an FTO meeting and refresher to be held on Friday with all the field training officers

- Coffee with a Cop was a bit hit. We plan on hosting more of these throughout the year
- Officer Tway had Bill Lathrop w/ Evansville Today do a ride along on third shift

Monthly Update:

Technology/Equipment/Building Update:

- Chief Reese is working on a grant for body armor which is due to be replaced in 2022
- Lt. Jones has been working on gathering more information on the live scan machine and all the requirements associated with operating one. Lt. Jones received word that we would be awarded approximately \$6,000 towards the purchase of a livescan machine. The cost could be significantly more
- Lt. Jones met with Jason regarding server needs of the department and for City Hall
- Waiting on quotes for painting the exterior of the PD and for the generators
- Squad 4 (2008 Tahoe) was going to be sold off this year because of the high value of used cars. Jason may be considering keeping it and using it for City Hall. Chief Reese is researching what it would cost to repair the Tahoe and make it useable for civilian employees including removing decals and police related equipment.

Police Commission/staffing:

- The Police Commission will meet on August 17th to decide on a candidate for full time and possibly part time. Right now we are conducting backgrounds on three candidates and expect those to be finished in the coming week

Month of July Highlights

Fourth of July events at Lake Leota were successful and EVPD had no significant issues. Officers were actively in the park and patrolling the City of Evansville.

1. All 6 stolen vehicles from Evansville have been recovered

 - i. 90% of these calls were Officer initiated, meaning Officers actively patrolling are noticing suspicious activity and taking action.
