- 1. Call to order by Chair Morrison at 6:01 pm
- 2. Roll call: Joy Morrison, James Espinosa, Lyman Fuson, Gene Prudhon, Sue Merritt, Mike Pfeil, and Matt Poock. Also inattendance: Jason Sergeant, Chad Renly, and Ray Anderson.
- 3. Motion to approve the agenda made by Espinosa and seconded by Fuson, approved on voice vote.
- 4. Motion to waive the reading of the July 20th, 2021 minutes and approve them as printed made by Fuson and seconded by Pfeil, and approved by voice vote.

- Park's report: Will be removing six trees this winter and five new have been planted. A
 pickleball demonstration was held in August and there is plan to do another demonstration in
 September.
 - A. Lake Leota Dam Repair (place holder): Chad has been in contact with Dan Stefans to check on the progress of the application. The hope is to get an RFP released in early spring.
 - B. 2021 creek walls & 2nd duck house (place holder): The creek walls have been completed and the duck pond is underway. Chad has received a quote for the restoration of the duck house.
 - C. Adopt-A-Park Program (place holder): Plan to get signage posted in the spring.
 - D. Dog Park is getting heavy use. Plan to plant some trees in the spring. Sidewalks will be installed next week.
- 8. Pool report: The pool repairs were successful and the leaking was minimal. New rubber will need to be installed next spring before the pool is filled. Winterizing the pool and park store has started.
- 9. Old business
 - A. Park & pool design update (place holder): Attached is a report from MSA. The initial

concept design should be released soon and will be followed by a public meeting. The City Council has approved the contract with Baker Street to do a feasibility study to raise \$1.5 million. Initial meeting is Wednesday, September 22. Espinosa asked about the athletics presentation at the MSA and which sports were represented.
