8. Evansville Police Department Report.

Officer Tway is working with the Evansville Fire District on putting together an active shooter training for the Police Department, Fire District, and Evansville EMS.

A Police Commission meeting will be held July, 11. Two candidates are recommended for part-time officer positions. This will be Bill Hurlley's first meeting as a member of the Police Commission after he was appointed by Common Council at the June meeting. Bill will replace Commissioner Floyd Hayes who passed away.

Calls for service are up from last year (1,174 in June 2022, compared to 849 in June 2021) and are more on pace with the usual number of calls for June after they were down last year, most likely due to COVID-19.

9. Evansville Emergency Medical Services Report. This is Carolyn Kleisch's first meeting as Acting Chief. EMS calls for service have increased from last year (362 so far in 2022, compared to 299 this time last year. Footville EMS was called for 5 mutual aid calls this month, they responded to 3 and were cancelled on 2.


